

“What Is Truth?”

Jesus is about to be crucified by Roman soldiers at the behest of the Jewish leaders. The *false accusation* which will get Jesus crucified is that He is a “**King**” in competition with Caesar. In reply to the inquiry Jesus calmly replies “*My kingdom is not of this world.
