**Editor’s Note:** This chart was designed and used by my father in a public debate with Olen West on the subject of “The Security of the Believer.” The two nights of discussion on that topic were October 13-14, 1977. The outline of Ephesians shows the **content** of the epistle of Paul and how *faithfulness to the Lord* was necessary to the salvation of the Ephesians and of us. One cannot discriminate against nationalities, disrupt the unity of the church, despise the Lord’s church, have fellowship with darkness, neglect your “works,” or resign as a “soldier” of Christ and still be saved. If you can, then why did Paul write these things?! Therefore, eternal salvation is not unconditional for the believer.
