A Malicious Agenda

Angelic visitors to Sodom and Gomorrah found out how immoral and malicious the cities were toward the morally innocent and godly. Today, the homosexual agenda is maliciously trying to destroy every vestige of religious privilege we have in this country.

Sodom

"Now before they lay down, the men of the city, the men of Sodom, both old and young, all the people from every quarter, surrounded the house. And they called to Lot and said to him, "Where are the men who came to you tonight? Bring them out to us that we may know them carnally" (Gen. 19:4-5). God had sent the angelic messengers to Sodom to see what the citizens would do. The wicked men of Sodom, both young and old, tried to force themselves sexually upon the new visitors in Lot's house. A valuable lesson about **wickedness** is that it cannot dwell peacefully with **righteousness**, and will attempt to destroy it when in a position to do so. The apostle Paul explained this mind set in Romans 1 when he wrote: "who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them" (v. 32). I suppose it is the contrary nature of good versus evil that causes such to be the case.

The Christian's Duty

Christians are taught, however, to "have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them. For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret. But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light" (Eph. 5:11-13). It is not the duty of Christians to **hate** the sinner, but to **hate sin** and to expose its inherent evil to those who might listen.

Houston's Mayor

Now it has come to the attention that the lesbian mayor of Houston, Texas, has **ordered** the preachers in that city to send her any material they might have about her or the subject of homosexuality.
