5. How many kings did "Israel" have after the division?
6. How many kings did "Judah" have after the division?
7. In what year B.C. did the nation of "Israel" fall to Assyria, never to rise as a nation again?
8. In what year B.C. did the nation of "Judah" and its capital, Jerusalem, fall to Babylon?
9. How many years were the survivors of the destruction of Jerusalem and Judah in captivity?
10. Approximately how many years did God remain "silent" between the end of the Old Testament (Malachi) and the beginning of the New Testament (the Gospels)?
