

The Gospel — A System of Mercy

“But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),” (Ephesians 2:4–5)

Mankind is here on the earth today because of God’s great mercy toward us. Everyone has sinned against God, Romans 3:23. *“All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all,”* Isaiah 53:6. Our perfect, righteous God laid our sins on the back of His only begotten Son because He is a God of great mercy as well! Can you fathom that?!

So God extends to us a Gospel (Good News) which says that if we will believe in Him, return back to God, and repent of our sins, then we can be saved by the Gospel — a system of mercy and forgiveness. In Jeremiah 31:34 (quoted in Hebrews 8:12), we read: *“For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.”* The Law of Moses, a **SYSTEM** of perfect obedience, could not do this! *“For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins”* Heb. 10:4. So the Old Testament system could not save imperfect man. God knew this! It was given to show to us that we **need** God’s mercy and kindness. Dear reader, are you now *spiritually dead* in trespasses and sins? Then why not come back to the God of mercy and find mercy, forgiveness, and hope again!
