Will The Church Here Die?

We don't like to think of the local church dying in any place. But the reality in America today is that only the strong churches will survive in the next decade. There are so many things working against Christianity in America — apathy and indifference by the younger generations, subtle attacks by the local, state, and federal governments, anti-Christian propaganda promoted by various special interests organizations like the Human Rights Campaign, Southern Poverty Law Center (SPLC), Freedom From Religion Foundation and the Gay, Lesbian & Straight Education Network (GLSEN), and a lack of strong faith even among our own members.

Church attendance is sporadic, volunteers to teach Bible classes, preach sermons, clean the building, help the elderly, and care about the church in general are hard to find. "Hold fast the pattern of **sound words** which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 1:13). Take the time to read and consider also Titus 1:9, 13; 2:1-2.
