

- 1. That they will come to a saving knowledge of Christ early in life, Ecclesiastes 12:1; Mark 10:15**
- 2. That they will hate sin, Psalm 97:10; Romans 7:14**
- 3. That they will be caught and genuinely repentant when they are guilty, Psalm 119:71; Romans 14:12; 2 Corinthians 7:10**
- 4. That they will be protected from the world, the flesh and the devil in each area of their lives -- spiritual, emotional, and physical, 2 Timothy 1:7; John 17:15; Psalm 4:8**
- 5. That they will have a responsible attitude in all their duties and dealing with people, Daniel 6:3; 1 Corinthians 4:2**
- 6. That they will respect those in authority over them, Romans 13:1; Ephesians 5:20; Hebrews 13:17; Ephesians 6:2**
- 7. That they will desire the right kind of friends, Proverbs 22:24; Proverbs 14:7; James 4:4**
- 8. That they, as well as those they marry, will be kept pure until marriage, 1 Corinthians 6:18-20; 1 Corinthians 7:1-2**
- 9. That they will be kept from the wrong mate and saved for the right one, 2 Corinthians 6:14**
- 10. That their future mates will learn to walk with God as they are, and that they will be prepared for the work God has for them together, Proverbs 22:6; Genesis 2:18**
- 11. That they will learn to totally submit to God and resist the devil, James 4:7; 1 Peter 5:8**
- 12. That they will be single-hearted, willingly committed to Jesus Christ, Romans 12:1-2; Psalm 40:8**
- 13. That they will grow in the Lord all their lives and will make separation a way of life, Colossians 1:9; 2 Peter 3:18**
- 14. That they will mightily love God and His Word, Deuteronomy 6:5; Job 23:12**
- 15. Let them know that you are praying for these things for them so that they will know how you expect them to live, Proverbs 22:17-21**
