Teach Them!

Teach them to be devoted husbands and wives and capable fathers and mothers. Do not leave this teaching to their peers, their school teachers, or even Bible class teachers. And God forbid that we should leave it to television programs, movies, paperbacks, and magazines!

A toll-free phone number was given, and the reader was informed that the transaction could be charged to MasterCard or Visa. It seems that as people are less and less committed to the life-time nature of marriage, others are more and more willing to help them get out of it. But Jesus still says, "What therefore God hath joined together let not man put asunder" (Matt. 19:6). And the Bible still enjoins: "Let marriage be had in honor among all, and let the bed be undefiled; for fornicators and adulterers God will judge" (Heb. 13:4).
