...Bible! In fact, one great example of the difference between godly worship and ungodly worship is found in the great contest between Elijah and the false prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18)! Elijah challenged the false prophets to take a bull for a sacrifice, cut it in pieces, lay fire on the altar, and let the gods light the fire! The prophets agreed to the contest, but no god lit the fire of their sacrifice! These false worshipers called on their gods from morning till noon, and received no answer. They cried aloud, and cut themselves, as was their custom, with knives and lances, until the blood gushed out on them (v. 28)! And still no god answered them.

By contrast, Elijah repaired the altar of Jehovah, placed twelve stones on the altar as a representation of the Twelve Tribes of Israel, and made a large trench around the altar, put the wood in order, cut the bull as a sacrifice in pieces, and laid the wood on the altar. When he then called upon the Name of the Lord, a mighty fire fell and consumed the burnt sacrifice, the wood and even the stones and the dust! Everything was done according to the order which God had commanded! (The only exception to this arrangement was the fact that Elijah poured four water pots over the sacrifice three times to prove that his offering was not a man-made hoax!)

## The Sun, Moon & Stars

Now look out into the universe and behold the wonders of God's creation! "The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork" (Ps. 19:1). Every day is a 24-hour period — the time it takes for the earth to rotate on its axis once. Every year is 365 1/4 days — the time it takes for the earth to revolve around the sun once. The laws of nature reflect the order and design inherent in the universe in which we live. Only a fool would view all of this beauty, design and organization and then declare "There is no God!"
