In advertising their product (church directories), the United Church Directories asked the question, "Why do people choose a church?" Thus, 56% are influenced by the direct or indirect contact of a member of the church.

The point is: the most proven method of teaching others is personal contact by Christians who care. Acts 8:4 says the disciples went everywhere preaching the Word. Let each and every one of us busy ourselves with contacting others with an aim to the salvation of their souls!
