(Leviticus 25:13-28; Ezra 2:70; Jeremiah 12:14) Genealogies are now forbidden (*Titus 3:9; 1 Timothy 1:4*)

The Earthly Throne Of David Ended With Coniah

(Jeremiah 22:24-30; 1 Chronicles 3:16, 17) Christ is a descendant of Coniah (*Matthew 1:12*)
